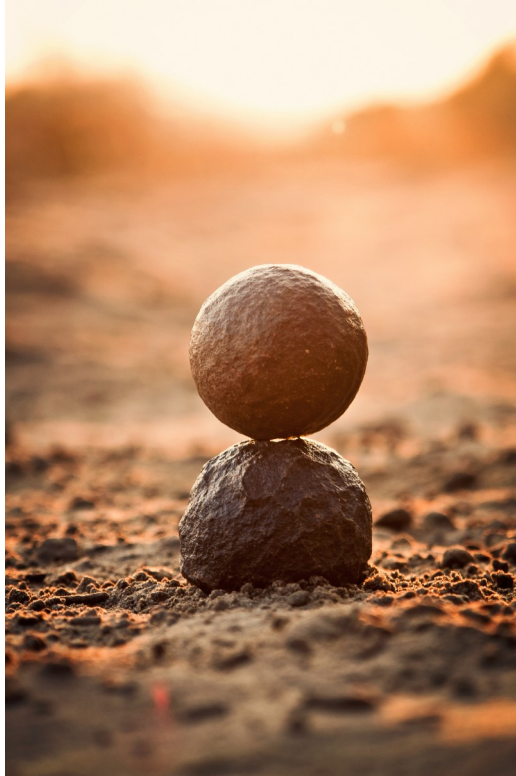

- ◇ Maintain Confidentiality

- ◇ Help you to connect with colleagues if you desire a support group or someone with expertise in a specific area of ministry
- ◇ Encourage your self-care in the areas of your professional, spiritual, physical, financial and family life
- ◇ Help you to find counselors, mentors, coaches, financial planners, spiritual directors as desired
- ◇ Provide knowledge of the resources in the Presbytery and through the Board of Pensions
- ◇ Be available to you and respond to your needs to the best of our ability
- ◇ Avoid situations and areas of ministry in the Presbytery that would put us in a conflict of interest in relationship to you
- ◇ Provide references for you, only if you request it of us and we have discussed the scope and details of the reference together
