Call to Order and Establishment of a Quorum

The meeting came to order at 9:02 a.m. A quorum was present. Moderator Peter Hulac and Stated Clerk Olivia Hudson Smith were present. Moderator Hulac opened with prayer. A quorum was established.

Prayer

Presbytery Moderator Peter Hulac opened with prayer in memory of John Kuzma who was recently killed in an automobile accident. The prayer was based on a Hymn with the text by Thomas Troeger, "Where Mountains Lift the Eye".

Welcome and Introductions | Peter Hulac

Pete welcomed corresponding members and asked them to introduce themselves including their home Presbytery. New ruling elder commissioners were asked to introduce themselves identifying the congregation which they represent.

Preliminary Business (Omnibus Motion)

The assembly approved:

- 1. **The Docket** as distributed, with such changes as announced at the start of the Assembly.
- 2. **Enrollment of Corresponding Members** and granting permission of the floor for those who introduced themselves and registered attendance.
- 3. Approve the minutes of the stated May 25, Assembly posted on the website.
- 4. **Receive all reports** of Council workgroups and Standing Committees in the Assembly documents packet.

Assembly at Worship

Vice Moderator, Rev. Paula Steinbacher, introduced worship. Rev. Kenny Shaw, South Park Community Church and Rev. Steinbacher lead the Assembly in Worship based on Colossians 3:12-17. The focus was how the mountain churches serve their communities and came together in service during the 2020 wild fires.

Assembly Business

Vision Construction Team and Process (VCT)

Corey Schlosser-Hall, began the report with an overview of the work of the Vision Construction Team (VCT), the timeline of the work thus far, and a snapshot of where the Presbytery of Denver is now and the vision for the future based on input from the four corners of the Presbytery. Each member of the VCT discussed one of the proposed eight values. The Assembly/Presbytery packet with the Mission Vision and Values (MVV), Ministry Information Form (MIF), and Ministry and Staffing Design (MSD) for first reading. There will be a Special Called Meeting on September 22, 2021, for a final vote; however, before then there will be four (4) open listening sessions for all in the Presbytery wishing to attend to provide feedback and ask questions.

Committee on Ministry (COM)

Judy Jenson reported providing information on Clergy Renewal Grants, information on which is on the Presbytery's website. Reverends Susan Boucher, Laura Sugg, and Geoff Kohler, three Minister Members who recently left the Presbytery where recognized and thanksgiving offered for their serve. The Presbytery of Denver will hold three upcoming installation services. Rev. Doug Friesema at First Presbyterian Church of Aurora, August 21, 2021, Rev. Dr. David Pettit at Providence Presbyterian Church on August 29, 2020, and Rev. Joes Adams on September 12, 2021, at First Presbyterian Church of Golden.

Highlands Camp Joint Committee

Beth Carlisle serves as ex-official staff liaison. She reported on the recent changes at the camp and challenges experienced by Presbytery of Denver member on the camp committee. Beth and Olivia Hudson Smith will meet with members of Plains and Peaks Presbytery Council and camp committee members in September. Beth introduced Terry Buchanan, an ordained Methodist Minister who formerly served as youth director in two Denver Presbytery churches who is the Interim Executive Director who spoke about current camp activities. While 2021 is the 75th anniversary of Highlands Camp, the celebration is May 14-15, 2022.

Council

Finance and Property Workgroup

Moved by Council that the Assembly approve Bethel Presbyterian Church's request to sell the church parking lot at 1394 King Street for no less than 90% of the recommended list price of \$1,150,000. **Approved.**

Racial Ethnic Diversity Workgroup (RED)

Evan Amo reported that the workgroup is sharing the stories of Denver Presbytery members in an ongoing effort to see and hear the stories on how race and ethnicity has informed faith formation, grounded in Colossians 3:11.

Treasurer

Sue Pilcher reported that the Presbytery received very little income in July 2021, \$7,727.00 and lost (\$3,278.00) in investment income during the same period. The internal financial review for 2020 conducted by three members of the Presbytery is completed. The review raised questions about how documentation is kept, and Sue and Chuck Sparks are making changes to the process. The Presbytery has greater controls in place to track funds coming in and going out.

Adjournment

The Assembly adjourned at 11:08 a.m. with the benediction and closing prayer offered by Rev. Peggy Marshall, First Presbyterian Church Leadville, based on a reflection from her grandmother, Helen Lowry Marshall.
